

Kitchen Measurement Guide

Simple measurements for cabinet planning and pricing.

BEFORE YOU START

Record all measurements in **inches** (do not round), write clearly, and have one person handle and record the measurements.

IMPORTANT

These measurements are for **planning and pricing**. Final field dimensions should be verified by the installer or other qualified professional before the cabinet order is finalized.

1 Room Outline, Walls & Ceiling

- Draw a simple outline of the room shape.
- Measure every wall **corner to corner** and continue around the room.
- Record ceiling height from the floor to the ceiling or base of any soffit.

2 Windows, Doors & Openings

- Mark each opening on the room outline.
- For windows, include the trim and record width, height, and distance from the floor.
- Record each opening's distance from the nearest wall corner. For doors, note the swing direction.

3 Plumbing, Electrical & Vents

- Mark the sink/plumbing centerline and other fixed plumbing locations.
- Mark outlets, switches, vents, radiators, or other fixed items that may affect cabinetry.
- Measure each fixed item from the nearest wall corner.

4 Sink & Appliances

- Measure or research the width, height, and depth of the sink and appliances.
- Mark the dishwasher in relation to the sink.
- Measure from a wall corner to the edge of the range and refrigerator.

5 Photos & Existing Plans

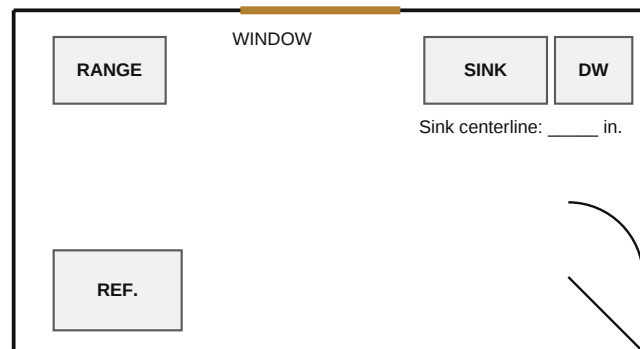
Take clear photos of **every wall** and the overall room. If available, include existing cabinet plans, appliance model numbers/spec sheets, or other drawings. Write the actual dimensions directly on your sketch.

TIP Photos from room corners are especially helpful for understanding the full space.

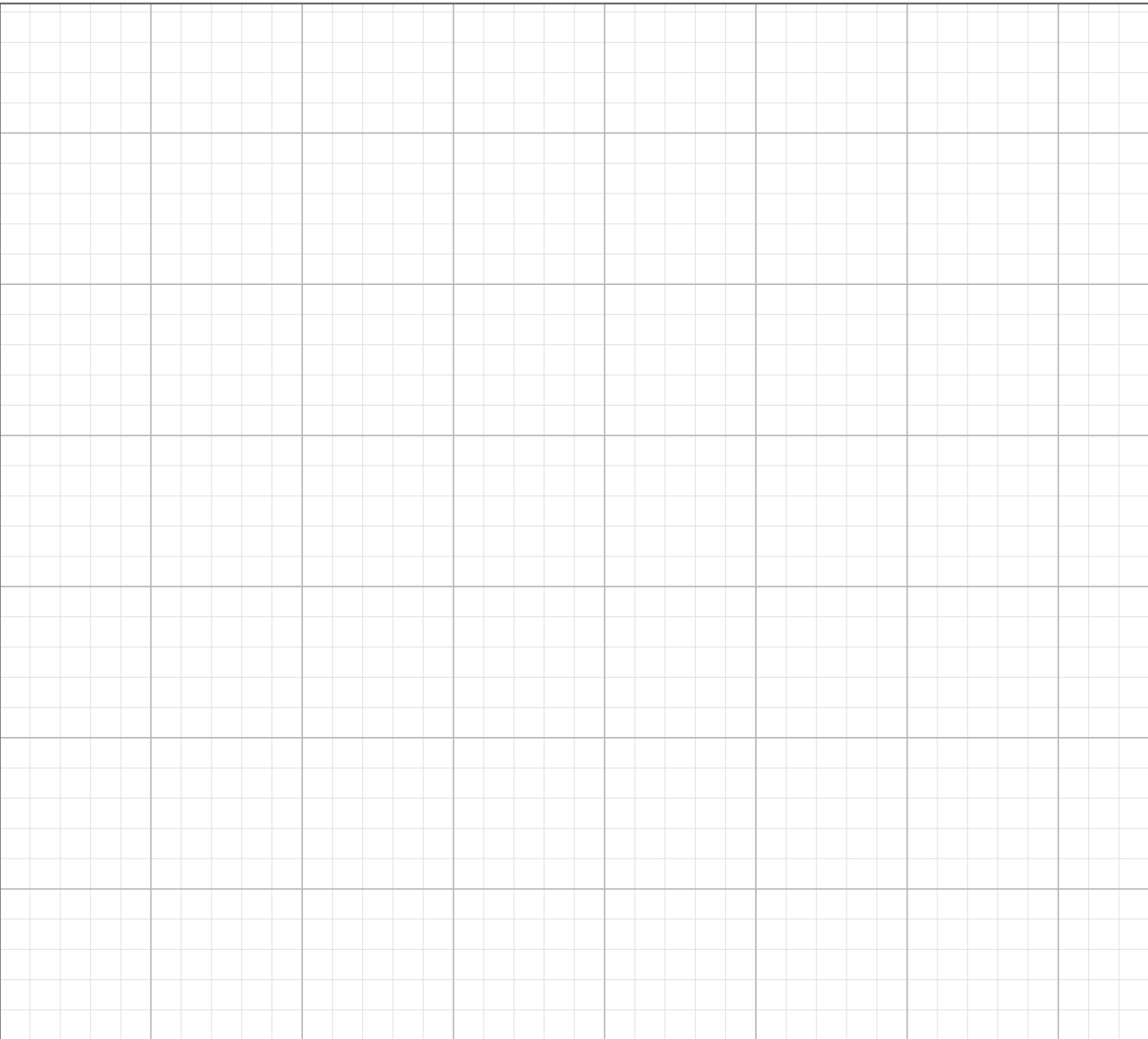
Project Notes / Appliance Models

Kitchen Sketch Graph Paper

Draw the room outline, mark fixed items, and write the actual measurements on the sketch.

MARK: walls - windows/doors - sink/plumbing - dishwasher - range - refrigerator - outlets/switches - vents/radiators - soffits or other fixed obstacles.
